Subject: 'F' Category Written Examination under Regulation 6 of CBLR, 2018 to be held on 06.03.2020-reg.

Kind attention is invited to the Press Release/Notice dated 22.08.2019 for Customs Broker Examination issued by the National Academy of Customs, Indirect Taxes and Narcotics, Faridabad. It is hereby notified that the Online written examination under Regulation 6 of the Customs Broker Licensing Regulation (CBLR, 2018) as amended, which is a pre-requisite for grant of Customs Brokers license will be conducted on 06.03.2020 by the NACIN, Faridabad.

2. Applications are invited from Indian citizens to appear in the online written examination for issuance of license to act as a Customs Broker under Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations (CBLR), 2018, as amended.

3. Complete application is to be submitted in person or by Registered/ Speed Post in Form-A (available in the CBLR, 2018) along with two passport size photos and self-attested documents on citizenship (Aadhaar/Passport/Voter Card), educational qualification, financial viability, mobile number, e-mail id and other requirements along with the prescribed fee of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) to the Principal Commissioner of Customs, Custom House, Mundra from **14.10.2019 to 15.11.2019 up to 06:00 PM**. Applications sent by post, in case received after the last date shall not be entertained.

4. Before submitting the application, applicant should ensure the completeness of the application. Incomplete applications shall be summarily rejected.

5. The online written examination will be a Computer Based Exam with Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of two and half hours (10:30 hrs to 13:00 hrs) duration. Questions will be bilingual i.e. in English and Hindi. The pattern of the examination will be as follows:

No. of questions: 150

Marking scheme: +3 for each correct answer

-1 for each incorrect answer

Maximum marks: 450

Qualifying marks: 270 (60%)

6. Syllabus of written examination will be as per regulation 6(7) of CBLR, 2018 as amended.

7. Names of applicants found eligible to appear in examination will be displayed on the notice board and/or website of the Mundra Commissionerate (www.mundracustoms.gov.in), in due course.

8. Information regarding roll number, admit card and examination venue will be made available on the website of CBIC and NACIN websites www.cbic.gov.in and www.nacin.gov.in under the icon/tab <GSTP/CBLR Exam>. A link to download the admit card will also be provided therein. Admit cards shall also be sent by email to eligible applicants 15 days before the date of examination. For convenience of candidates, other necessary details like list of centres, guidelines to the candidates, help desk, e-mail id. etc will also be made available under the said icon/tab. **The date and time of written examination shall be 06.03.2020 from 10:30 hrs-13:30 hrs.**

9. Successful candidate will be called for oral Examination for which separate communication will be sent.

10. The oral examination will be held during the second quarter of the calendar year 2020. The pass percentage marks for qualifying in the oral examination will be 60%. A dummy question paper for the purpose of awareness of candidates will be made available on the CBIC and NACIN websites www.cbic.gov.in and www.nacin.gov.in under the icon/tab <GSTP/CBLR Exam> from February, 2020.


11. In case declarations and information submitted by the applicant are found to be incorrect, the application shall be rejected or license, (if issued) shall be cancelled.

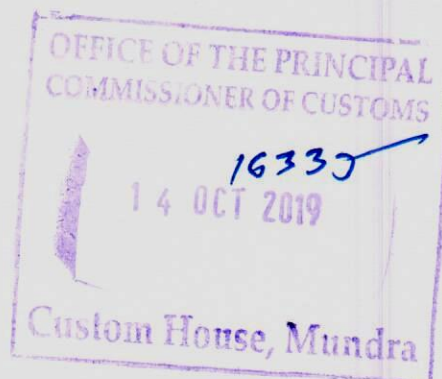

1. Applications are invited from Indian citizens to appear in the online written examination for issuance of license to act as a Customs Broker under Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations (CBLR), 2018, as amended. A copy of the regulations is available at www.cbic.gov.in and www.nacen.gov.in.
2. Complete application is to be submitted in person or by Registered/ Speed Post in Form-A (available in the CBLR, 2018) along with two passport size photos and self attested documents on citizenship (Aadhaar/ Passport/ Voter Card), educational qualification, financial viability and other requirements along with the prescribed fee of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) to the Principal Commissioner/ Commissioner of Customs/ Commissioner of Customs (Prev), having jurisdiction over the area where the applicant intends to carry on his business from 14.10.2019 to 15.11.2019 up to 06:00 PM. Applications sent by post, in case received after the last date shall not be entertained.
3. Before submitting the application, applicant should ensure the completeness of the application. Incomplete applications shall be summarily rejected.
4. Syllabus of written examination will be as per regulation 6(7) of CBLR, 2018.
5. Names of applicants found eligible to appear in examination will be displayed on the notice board and/or website of the respective commissionerate latest by 22.11.2019.
6. Information regarding roll number, admit card and examination venue will be made available on the website of CBIC and NACIN under the icon/tab <GSTP/CBLR Exam>. A link to download the admit card will also be provided therein. Admit cards shall also be sent by email to eligible applicants 15 days in advance before the date of examination. The date and time of written examination shall be 06.03.2020 from 10:30 hrs-13:30 hrs.
7. The candidates have the option to answer either in Hindi or in English.

8. Successful candidates will be called for an oral examination for which separate communication will be sent.

 - (e) he has not been penalised for any offence under the Act, the Central Excise Act, 1944 (1 of 1944), the Finance Act, 1994(32 of 1994), the Central Goods and Services Act, 2017 (12 of 2017) and Integrated Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 (13 of 2017);
- (ii) Two passport size photographs and Self Attested Copy of Aadhar Card/ Passport/ Voter Card.
- (iii) Certificate issued by Government Civil Surgeon stating that the applicant is a person of sound mind

- (vii) Bank solvency certificate of Rs. 5,00,000/- issued by a Scheduled Bank/Certificate issued by Tehsildar (with proper validity) stating that the applicant is in possession of assets of value not less than Five Lakh Rupees.
