PUBLIC NOTICE NO: 21/2019

Subject: Amendment in Para 2.54 (d)(v)(iv) of Handbook of Procedures, 2015-2020 - Reg.

Kind attention of the members of the trade (importer/exporters /customs brokers) and all persons concerned is invited to the Public Notice No. 75/2015-2020, dated 25.02.2019 issued by the Director General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) regarding amendments in Para 2.54(d)(v)(iv) of the Handbook of Procedures 2015- 2020.

2. Vide the said Public Notice dated 25.02.2019, the DGFT has amended Para 2.54(d)(v)(iv) of HBP to read as under:

"Import consignments of metallic waste and scrap shall be subject to pre-inspection certificate (PSIC) from the country of origin. However, metallic waste and scrap(both shredded and unshredded) imported from safe countries/region i.e. the USA, the UK, Canada, New Zealand, Australia and the EU will not require PSIC if consignments are cleared through seven (7) ports namely Chennai, Tuticorin, Kandla, JNPT, Mumbai, Krishnapatnam and Mundra. Consignments from these five countries/region will be accompanied by certificate from the supplier/scrap yard authority to the effect that it does not contain any radioactive materials/explosives. These will however be subject to radiation and explosive checks through portal monitors and container scanner at these ports. Transshipments through these countries/regions will not be allowed this facility. Import through all other ports including nine (9) ports for unshredded scrap/waste, irrespective of country of origin, will be subject to PSIC."


3. The procedure to follow for such Consignments from these countries/regions without PSIC would be as follows:

- (a) Consignments will be accompanied by certificate from the supplier/scrap yard authority to the effect that it does not contain any radioactive materials/explosives.
- (b) The Containers would be subjected to radiation and explosive checks through portal monitors installed at South Basin Customs Gate. The

importer/Custom Broker would ensure that such containers pass through portal monitors. If the container is selected for scanning, then the same would be scanned at Drive-through X-ray based Container Scanner Facility.

Action to be taken in terms of decisions taken in this Public Notice should be considered as standing order for the purpose of officers and staff.
